

FSGC CHAMPIONSHIP – 2022

The Fairway Social Golf Club Championships will be played over 4 matches and the best 3 results for a player will be considered to determine the Club Champion. The match will be conducted over 4 rounds on 21st August 2022, 4th September 2022, 16th October 2022 & 30th October 2022. The **2022** Club Champion will be the player who has the lowest possible score over the best 3 rounds out of the 4 rounds played. Each round will be scored based on the Golf course par rating and the player's gross score, which is converted to a net score by considering his handicap.

The result will be a number either above or below the course par. The 3 best rounds will be added to form the final result for a player. Example : player A on a HC of 15 has scores as follows:

Round	Course Par	Gross Score	HC	Net score	Result
1	72	86	15	71	-1
2	70	90	15	75	+5
3	72	88	15	73	+1
4	69	86	15	71	+2

Final Result for Player A: +2 (-1+1+2: the 3 best rounds) ; ie 2 over par

FORMAT OF COMPETITION

Players will play off their AGU handicap as of the day the game is held.

This HC will be as at the time of the game and not locked for the duration of the Championship round.

The scoring will be based on stroke play and the net score will be recorded as over and under par for each round.

The players will be ceded, in rounds 3 and 4, based on their scores of rounds 1 and 2.

In case of a round being washed out, the best 2 of the 3 rounds will be used to determine the Champion.

In case two or more rounds are washed out, then the Club Championship Competition will be called off.

The 2022 Club Champion will be the player who has the lowest score recorded over the best 3 rounds out of the 4 rounds played. If there is a tie when the result is calculated, then all 4 rounds of the players tied, will be used to determine the Winner. If this is still a tie or if the tied player/s have not played all four rounds, then count back will be used on the last common round for the players tied, to determine the winner.

If there is a tie, when there has been a wash out, then count back will be used on the last common round for the players, to determine the winner.

CONDITIONS OF THE COMPETITION

The following Conditions, in concert with any other additions or amendments as published, will apply

1. Eligibility

For a player to be eligible they must meet the following criteria:

- a) To be fully paid up member of FSGC.
- b) To have a registered handicap in Golf Link prior to the commencement of the first round of the Championship.
- c) For a player to be eligible for the Championship, he needs to **have played** the required number of games including **club championship round, (12 –as approved at the AGM)**. **Exemptions to the eligibility are available on a case by case basis as approved by the executive committee.**
- e) A player may either walk the course or use a cart.

****Exception for 2022****

The club championship is open to all paid members

2. Returning of Score Card

The responsibility for knowing the Rules lies with all players. In stroke play, the player and his marker have an explicit responsibility for the correctness of the player's score card.

A player's score card is deemed officially returned to the Committee when the player has handed their score card to a competition committee member. It is a player's responsibility to see that his card has been filled correctly, **both marker & player must sign the card.**

For any issues or in an event where there may be a dispute among the player and the marker, please refer this to the committee with full details for the issue and any supportive information (such as input from other members of the group) for a resolution, before submitting the cards

3. Scoring inaccuracy

Any errors in the score cards will incur a 2 stroke penalty, for the player as well as the marker. For any contentious ruling during play whereby a decision cannot be made, it is recommended that two balls are played and both scores recorded, and the issue then referred to the match committee for a ruling.

4. Disqualification

In the event that a player is disqualified from one round, he can still play in the competition provided he completes the number of minimum rounds required for the competition.

5. How to Decide Ties

In the event that the result is a tie, refer to the Format of the competition, for further details of deciding the winner.

6. Results of the Competition – Competition Closed

The competition is closed when all scores have been approved by the Committee.

7. Local Rules

All standing and temporary local rules of the Golf Course being played on will be observed. Check with the competition committee on the day.
